My View on the Fairness of Timed Tests

Timed tests, as a traditional assessment method, require students to complete exams with a fix time frame. While this practice has long been integral to educational systems, debates about its fairness persist.

Proponents argue that timed test establishes a universal standard of fairness. Since all candidates face identical pressure and challenges, this format eliminates biases and ensures equal opportunities. However, critics hold that strict time constraints may fail to reflect students' true abilities. Anxiety-prone individuals or those needing more time to process information might underperform, creating an unequal evaluation.

From my perspective, timed tests are partially fair but require flexibility. Though timed tests provide a relatively objective and fair way to measure students' knowledge and skills, they should not be the sole evaluation method. A balanced approach—combining timed exams with untimed projects, oral presentations or coursework—would offer a general measure of student abilities, which helps compare students' academic performance on a larger scale.
